Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted via telephone conference call on September 22, 2025.

Michael Nacmias, attorney for Respondent appeared at the hearing. No appearance on behalf of petitioner NYPD.

The summons charges code section 10-125(b) for open alcoholic container. Respondent's respondent motioned to dismiss for no jurisdiction since a blank affidavit was filed. Also, Respondent's representative motioned to dismiss for non prima facie case since the summons does not describe an alcoholic beverage or alcohol volume.

According to 48 RCNY 6-08(a)(1), the petitioner must file an original or a copy of the summons, together with proof of service, with the Tribunal prior to the first scheduled hearing date. Electronic filing of the summons and proof of service is required unless the Tribunal grants an exception. Failure to timely file all proofs of service shall not divest the Tribunal of jurisdiction to proceed with a hearing or to issue a default order. This summons is dismissed for no jurisdiction since a blank affidavit of service was filed with the summons.
