Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent, David Dzotsenidze, is charged with violation of 34 RCNY 4-10(D)(7)(V), for unlawful stopping. The Issuing Officer observed Respondent stop and let out passenger in clearly posted no stopping anytime zone sign. This observation occurred on September 14, 2025, at 12:56 p.m., at 34th Avenue, in Queens, New York.

At the hearing, Michael Nacmias, Esq., represented the Respondent, David Dzotsenidze. There was no appearance by Petitioner, NYC Police Department.

Mr. Nacmias made a motion to dismiss asserting defective service as the Affidavit of Service is blank and unsigned. Petitioner

has no jurisdiction over the named respondent and cited to Appeal No. 2000420. As to the merits, Respondent made a motion to dismiss asserting Respondent is charged with violating the wrong section of law, it applies to buses.

I credit the testimony and evidence submitted in this case on behalf of the Petitioner and Respondent. I hereby grant Respondent's motion to dismiss for defective service. Upon review of the Affidavit of Service, it is completely blank and lacks a signature.

Accordingly, this summons is Dismissed.
