Findings of Facts & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner, NYC Environmental Protection, did not appear. Respondent appeared by ILMA BABU, authorized representative .

This hearing was conducted via telephone on December 5, 2025.

Respondent is charged with Code § 24-163, in that there was a citizen-complainant that observed Respondent's vehicle, idling for longer than three minutes.

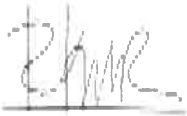
Respondent denied the violation but offered no rebuttal evidence.

Code § 24-163(a) provides in pertinent part:

(a) No person shall cause or permit the engine of a motor vehicle, other than a legally authorized emergency motor vehicle, to idle for longer than three minutes . . . while

parking as defined in section one hundred twenty-nine of the vehicle and traffic law [VTL], standing as defined in section one hundred forty-five of the [VTL], or stopping as defined in section one hundred forty-seven of the [VTL], unless the engine is used to operate a loading, unloading or processing device. [Emphasis added.]

Respondent asserted it had received and reviewed petitioner's evidence, and would deny, but not rebut, the allegations in the summons. I credit the summons. The summons is for violating Code § 24-163 is sustained and the standard civil penalty is imposed for the 1st offense.
