Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted on January 6, 2026, by Court Call. Petitioner appeared through Leah Smith. Respondent, Hugh O'Kane Electric Company, Inc., appeared through their authorized representative, Ilma Babu.

The summons charges a violation of 24-163 of the Administrative Code in that Respondent caused or permitted the idling of a motor vehicle while parked, standing, or stopped for more than three minutes. The issuing officer states that, as per DEP records, a citizen observed a Truck with NY license plate no. 27260MM idling for longer than three minutes from 8/12/2024 12:03:10 PM to 8/12/2024 12:06:40 PM at the intersection of Smith Street and Bergen Street, in Brooklyn. This is cited as a third offense with summons nos. 000729352H and 000742575L cited on the face of the summons as prior violations.

Petitioner rests on the summons.

Respondent denies, but offers no rebuttal to, the allegations set forth in the summons. Petitioner does not contest the validity of the prior summonses cited on the face of the instant summons.

I credit the statements of the issuing officer. Petitioner has established a prima facie case.

Accordingly, the Summons is sustained.
