Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Joshua Santis appeared on behalf of Respondent for a phone hearing on July 14, 2025 in response to the above-issued summons. Senior Insp. Antwan Gibbs appeared on behalf of Petitioner Department of Environmental Protection.

Petitioner relied on the sworn statements contained in the summons. Petitioner submitted video evidence of the idling vehicle; the citizen complaint; and photos showing the vehicle and license plate.

Respondent claimed that this should be a second offense, as one of the prior summonses does not include the DBA name of Respondent and is therefore a different Respondent. Respondent did not contest the merits of the instant violation.

Petitioner claimed that the prior violations were issued to the named Respondent and same vehicle, and not including the DBA name on one of the summonses does not render it an invalid prior.

I credit the observations contained in the summons, and the evidence submitted, and find that Petitioner proved this violation by a preponderance of the evidence. I do not credit Respondent's argument and find that the priors are valid. Therefore, the summons is sustained and a third offense penalty is imposed.
