Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent, Barosa was issued the above-listed summons. Nora Brown appeared remotely as Respondent's authorized representative. Khadija Hassan appeared remotely on behalf of the Petitioner.

The summons alleges a VC 19 violation for failing to provide required documentation. The summons charges a repeat violation.

The petitioner rested on the details of the summons and offered the details of the prior violation on the record.

Respondent's representative requested an adjournment to have the name of the Respondent removed from the account arguing

that they are the commercial tenant and not the owner. The Petitioner objected arguing that the commercial tenant can be named since they are a party in control of the cited location.

I find the Respondent as the commercial tenant within the cited location is a properly named party and the hearing was allowed to proceed.

The Respondent's representative denied the details of the summons but did not offer a defense.

I credit the undisputed findings of the issuing officer and find that the cited condition did exist. Without a defense put forth to the contrary, the summons is prima facie evidence of the details alleged.

Accordingly, the summons is sustained as a repeat violation.
