Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The Respondent, DAM PLASTICS INDST CORP., appeared by its Attorney-at-Law, MICHAEL SARGO, ESQ. Petitioner appeared by JOANNE GUERRA. The summons alleges a violation of VC 4, VC 5, and VC 25. The details of the violating

conditions are specified in the supplementary form attached to the summons.

The matter was originally scheduled to be heard on 1/5/2026 and was fully heard on this instant date, 2/9/2026.

Ms. Guerra rested the Petitioner's case on the sworn allegations in the summons. Mr. Sargo did not dispute the facts; however, he presented photographs to show that the conditions are corrected in the manner required by the Petitioner. (RXA). Ms. Guerra reviewed the evidence and found them satisfactory to show timely correction of the violating conditions.

I credit the Petitioner's case and I find that the violating conditions existed as alleged. I find the Respondent liable as charged and on its credible evidence of timely correction, I impose the reduced penalty for each VC. The summons is sustained.
