Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The Respondent, JEAN-BAPTISTE SERGE, appeared by online submission on December 26, 2025.

The Respondent is charged with failing to clean 18 inches into the street. In that, the issuing officer stated he or she observed "ashtray contents, bottle(s), cup(s), napkins, piece(s) of paper, wrappers matted within the 18 inch curb line, during the established routing hour of 8:00AM-8:59AM."

Respondent states the litter may have been "deposited by passersby and can accumulate rapidly even after proper cleaning."

For a one- to two-family dwelling, twice-daily cleanings are required. No cleaning schedule was presented.

I credit the statement of the issuing officer that he or she observed the cited accumulation of litter in front of the Respondent's curb,
within 18 inches of the curb line during the routing hour of 8:00AM-8:59AM.

Accordingly, the summons is sustained and the minimum penalty of \$50 is imposed.
