Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner DSNY was not present. Attorney Caroline Kane appeared on behalf of Respondent DAKOTA UNITED GROUP LLC at telephone hearing on December 26, 2024. Respondent's counsel waived the use of a translator, the presence of the issuing officer, and a formal reading of the summons.

Respondent was charged with violating section 16-118(2)(a) of the Administrative Code. Date of occurrence was on 01/10/2020.

Respondent's counsel argued the summons should be dismissed because the date of occurrence was illegible. Otherwise,

they denied the allegations and offered no rebuttal. No additional evidence was submitted.

I credit the sworn statement of the issuing officer and Petitioner established the violation. Respondent offered no rebuttal and failed to present a valid legal defense. Respondent's motion to dismiss is denied because the date of occurrence is legible.

Therefore, the summons is sustained, and the standard penalty is imposed.
