Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

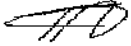
Petitioner, NYPD was not present for the telephone hearing. Respondent Jeff Delmar was represented by attorney Michael Nacmias.

The summons alleges " Failure to yield. Physical Injury."

Mr. Nacmias moved to dismiss stating that the blank affidavit of service fails to provide jurisdiction. He referenced appeal No. 200420. He also stated that the details of the summons fail to make a prima facie case in that there is no detail regarding who failed to yield, was the respondent driving, what vehicle was involved, or if there was a pedestrian who had the right of

way.

The statements of the officer in the summons are credited. However, they fail to establish prima facie under the cited section of law. There are no factual details. Accordingly, the summons is dismissed.
