Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent received an NYPD summons for a violation of section 19-190(B) of the New York City Administrative Code for failure to yield. In the summons, the issuing officer (IO) stated that on October 21, 2024, at 4:45 PM "Respondent did fail to yield to a pedestrian on a marked crosswalk causing physical injury" at 83rd Street and 95th Avenue.

In a phone in hearing, Mr. Michael Nacmias, attorney for Respondent, appeared. He made a motion to dismiss as service is defective. The affidavit of service is blank. Further, on the merits, Mr. Nacmias stated that the summons does not allege that Respondent is in a motor vehicle or a sufficient description of the personal injury.

Here, I find that service is defective as the affidavit of service is blank. As such, based on the foregoing, I dismiss the violation.
