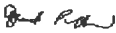

Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent, JOHN J KAZAS, appeared by their Attorney-at-Law, MICHAEL NACMIAS, ESQ. No one appeared for the Petitioner. The summons alleges a violation for a failure to yield to pedestrian right of way in the crosswalk. The details state that at tpo, the IO was informed that named individual "was struck by above listed motorist while crossing in the crosswalk causing injuries".

Counsel moved to dismiss the violation on the basis that the details as alleged fail to support the injury element of the charge and that the affidavit of service is blank. Counsel's motions are granted. It is well settled that a blank affidavit is not proper to support due service of process and it is a fact that the details do not adequately the material elements of the charge. Based

on the foregoing, the summons is dismissed.
