Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Michael Nacmias, Attorney for Respondent, VERONICA HUERTO appeared for a hearing by telephone on March 14, 2025. Petitioner, New York City Police Department, did not appear.

Respondent is charged with a violation of Section 19-190(b) of the NYC Administrative Code. The issuing officer states that Respondent failed to yield to a pedestrian and there were injuries. The Affidavit of Service was left blank.

Section 19-190(b) of the Administrative Code of the City of New York provides, in relevant part, that any driver of a motor vehicle who fails to yield to a pedestrian who has the right of way and whose motor vehicle causes contact with and injury to that pedestrian, shall, in addition to being guilty of a misdemeanor, be subject to a civil penalty of not more than \$250. For purposes of this section, "physical injury" shall have the same meaning as in section 10.00 of the penal law.

Under Penal Law § 10.00 (10), a serious physical injury is defined as one that causes death, serious and protracted disfigurement, protracted impairment of health, or protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily organ.

I credit the summons, and while it does mention that the driver caused physical injury it fails to meet the definition of physical injury under Penal Law § 10.00. In addition, the Affidavit of Service is blank rendering service defective. Accordingly, the Summons is dismissed
