Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

This hearing was conducted remotely by telephone. Michael Nacmias Esq. appeared for Respondent. Petitioner was not present. Respondent was charged with a violation of section 16-118(6) of the NYC Administrative Code.

Mr. Nacmias denied the allegations contained in the summons and made a motion to dismiss based upon the fact that the Affidavit of Service is blank.

The summons is defective as the affidavit of service page is blank. The Board has stated in NYPD v. Ajaz B. Kiani, Appeal No. 1801238 (June 18, 2020), that upon Respondent's challenge to service, Petitioner failed to establish proper service where

the purported proof of service on the reverse side of the summons was left blank and not signed and Petitioner did not appear at the hearing to supplement its proof of service. Accordingly , the summons is defective on its face and it is dismissed.
