Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner NYPD did not appear. Attorney Michael Nacmias appeared on behalf of AMADOU PATHE DIALLO at telephone hearing on November 10, 2025. Respondent's counsel waived the present of the issuing officer and a formal reading of the charges.

Respondent was charged with violating section 19-136(B) of the Administrative Code. Date of occurrence was 09/21/25.

Respondent's counsel argued that a moped is not a motor vehicle the allegations have nothing to do with a sale. There is nothing about Respondent's conduct that constitute a violation under the cited rule. No additional evidence was submitted.

19-136(b) states "It shall be unlawful for any person, directly or indirectly, to use any portion of a sidewalk or courtyard, established by law, between the building line and the curb line for the parking, storage, display or sale of motor vehicles."

I credit the sworn statement of the issuing officer but find that they failed to establish a violation. I find Respondent's argument to have merit.

Therefore, the summons is dismissed.
