Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

This summons was issued as a result of an inspection conducted on 5-8-25 at 4:48pm. Michael Nacmias, attorney for respondent, appeared by online submission.

LINE ITEM 1

This charges current valid permit to operate a food service establishment issued by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene not provided in that permit expired on 04/30/2025. FSE observed open and in operation. Mr. Nacmias said "this was a clerical or administrative oversight; the operator had every intention of renewing the permit on time and believed it had been processed. The inspection was conducted only 8 days after the permit expired, and the renewed permit was issued shortly thereafter. Please see attached." A copy of a permit issued on 5-20-25 was attached.

I credit the charge and find that it makes out a violation of the cited code section. The claim that the violation was due to an oversight, that the operator believed the permit had been processed, and that the permit was renewed after the inspection, even if true, are not defenses to the charge. Accordingly, I sustain this Line Item.
