Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner, the New York City Police Department, charges Respondent, STEVE KNYAZHEVSKY, with a violation of Section 19-190(b) of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, for failure to yield to a pedestrian with a right of way and causing the pedestrian's injury.

A telephonic hearing was held on May 28, 2025. Petitioner did not appear at the hearing. Michael Nacmias, Esq. appeared for Respondent, and waived the presence of the Issuing Officer.

Mr. Nacmias argued, among other things, that service of the summons was not proper. A review of the tribunal records revealed that the Affidavit (Certificate) of Service page is blank. As such, Petitioner failed to establish that the summons was properly served.

Accordingly, the summons is dismissed.
