Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Michael Nacmias, attorney for Respondent AMENDA AHMED, appeared at a telephone hearing on August 5, 2025. Petitioner NYPD did not appear.

The summons alleges a violation of NYC AC 19-190(b) because "respondent struck pedestrian in crossway causing injury, while driving vehicle." Respondent's attorney testified that the summons was defective because it did not state a prima facie case and did not identify a physical industry. Additionally, Respondent's counsel argued that the affidavit of service was blank.

On this record, I credit Respondent's testimony and find the summons was defective because it left out pertinent information related to the charge. I also credit Respondent's testimony that there was improper service. The Board has held that a blank affidavit is improper.

Accordingly, this summons is dismissed.
