Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent appears by online submission (Exhibit A) by representative, Michael Nacmias.

The summons charges Respondent with a violation of 16-118(2)(a) of the New York City Administrative Code.

The representative moves to dismiss the summons based on the following: the Petitioner did not meet the burden of connecting the trash to the Respondent.

§16-118(2)(a) of the Administrative Code of the City of New York requires that every owner, lessee, tenant, occupant or person in charge of any building or premises keep "sidewalks, air shafts, areaways, backyards, courts and alleys free from garbage, refuse, rubbish, litter, and other offensive material" and "shall remove garbage, refuse, litter, debris, and other offensive material between the curbstone abutting the building or premises and the roadway area extending one and one-half feet from the curbstone into the street on which the building or premises front."

I credit the issuing officer's observations and find facts sufficient to establish a violation under the above-referenced section of law.

I find that a credible, valid defense has not been established.

Accordingly, the summons is sustained and the minimum penalty of \$50 is imposed.
