Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The summons is dismissed and Cynthia U-Ahk does not have to pay a fine.

Michael Nacmias, Esq. appeared by telephone and said that he is the attorney for Ms. U-Ahk. No representative appeared for petitioner Police Department. The summons said that "motorist failed to yield and collided with pedestrian. Motorist stated she did not see pedestrian at crosswalk." It charged that this was a violation under Administrative Code section 19-190(b) and the hearing was held on October 9, 2025.

Mr. Nacmias said that the summons did not state who had the right of way and did not state that the pedestrian incurred any

physical injury.

I credit the foregoing testimony. Admin. Code section 19-190(b) requires a showing that there was physical injury as a result of contact with a pedestrian. In this case, the summons does not include any allegation that there was physical injury. The summons is therefore dismissed.
