Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent Syed Gillani is charged with a violation of VTL 190-B in that it is alleged he failed to yield the right of way to a pedestrian causing injury.

Mr. Gillani appeared through his attorney, Michael Nacmias, Esq. Mr. Nacmias argued that the summons was facially insufficient because there was no affidavit of service, the summons did not describe the injury, and the details of violation did not set forth which party had the right of way. Mr. Nacmias made a motion to dismiss the violation based on the above.

A review of the summons shows that it is defective. First, there is only a blank affidavit of service which is a due process

requirement. Second, the details of violation fail to indicate with any specificity details about the accident itself.

I find that the face of the summons fails to make out a prima facie case.

Based on the foregoing, the violation is dismissed.
