Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

This is a hearing by phone held October 2, 2025. Respondent, Rosylin Friedman, appeared by Michael Nacmias, Esq. Petitioner, Police Department, did not appear.

Summons 0218195506 alleges a violation of NYC Administrative Code 19-190(b).

Respondent's attorney moved to dismiss upon service and the merits. He argued service is defective per Appeal No. 2000420. He also stated Petitioner failed to establish a prima facie case because the statement on the summons is a conclusory restatement of the section of law.

Service is defective. The checkbox on the face of the summons is not checked. The affidavit of service is blank. Petitioner failed to appear to supplement service.

Accordingly, the summons is dismissed.

If I were not dismissing upon service grounds, I would still dismiss the summons for Petitioner's failure to establish a prima facie case as the summons makes no mention that Respondent was driving a motor vehicle and hit a pedestrian or a person on a bicycle.
