The hearing was held on November 20, 2025, via CourtCall.

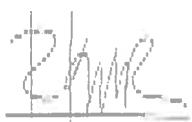
#0218920011 Sandra Ali - Respondent was charged with one count of 19-190 - Failure to Yield.

Respondent made a motion to dismiss and states that the affidavit of service is defective and relied on Appeal No. 2000420 NYPD v. Barrett Cherelle June 18, 2020 and Appeal No. 1801238 NYPD v. Ajaz B. Kiani June 18, 2020.

Respondent also argued that the summons does not connect the injury to the motorist or describe the injury.

I agree with Respondent's attorney and find that the affidavit of service is not dated, signed or sworn to by the issuing officer. I also agree that the violation fails to connect Respondent's action to the physical injury.

Therefore, the violation is dismissed.
