Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent is charged with a violation under NYC AC 19-190(B).

Michael Nacmias, Esq. appeared on behalf of Respondent and made an initial motion to dismiss, arguing the relevant affidavit of service is blank, so Petitioner failed to provide proof of service to OATH, resulting in OATH not having jurisdiction over this

summons.

He made a second motion to dismiss on the merits, arguing the summons fails to make out a prima facie case and only contains a conclusory restating of the charging section of law. He also stated the summons fails to connect Respondent to any conduct, and there is no allegation of the use of a motor vehicle, and there is no statement that a pedestrian was involved.

I find the relevant affidavit of service is blank, indicating Petitioner failed to provide proof of service to OATH.

As such, the summons is DISMISSED.

I find it unnecessary to address the merits.
