Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted by phone on December 26, 2025. Petitioner did not appear. Respondent appeared through Michael Nacmias, Esq.

Respondent was charged with a violation of AC 19-190(b).

Mr. Nacmias moved to dismiss on service and lack of a prima facie case. He noted that the affidavit (certificate) of service was not completed or signed and that the IO failed to alleged that Respondent operated a motor vehicle, failed to yield, or struck an individual who had the right of way. He argued that the alleged physical injury was not pleaded with sufficient

specificity.

I find the IO failed to complete the affidavit (certificate) of service. I also find that the summons fails to state a prima facie case.

Therefore, I dismiss the summons.
