Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent appeared by its authorized representative Michael Nacmias, Esq. Petitioner appeared by Ejaz Ahmad.

The Summons alleges a violation of AC 19-102(II) Failure to Comply with Terms and Conditions of DOT Permits, in that, on 11/29/2024 at 10:14am on 8th Avenue between West 23rd Street and West 24th Street, Respondent parked a non commercial vehicle in the work zone.

AC 19-102(ii) provides that the permittee must comply with the Terms and Conditions of DOT Permits.

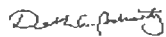
Petitioner submitted an email of 10 pages including the Summons, the DOT Permit containing Stip 103 (p 2) and 6 photos.

Respondent denied the vehicle was in the work zone submitted a Google Map for 9/2024 to argue that the entire segment of the street was not the work zone.

Petitioner responded that the car is in the work zone as it is on the East side of 8th Avenue between West 23rd Street and West 24th Street. Petitioner submitted plans for the work zone.

Respondent has not rebutted the Summons.
