Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Michael Nacmias, Esq. appeared for respondent, Petitioner did not appear.

This summons was issued for an alleged violation of 19-190(b); failure to yield to pedestrian.

Respondent's counsel challenged service as the affidavit of service on file is blank and unsigned and cited to appeal No. 2000420, which held, *Petitioner failed to establish proper service where the purported proof of service on the reverse side of the summons was left blank and not signed and Petitioner did not appear at the hearing to supplement its proof of service.*

In the alternative respondent moved to dismiss the summons for failure to establish a prima facie case as a physical injury was not alleged and that respondent had no right of way was not alleged.

I find service was improper as the affidavit of service filed with the summons is completely blank and unsigned and petitioner did not appear to submit any other proof of service.

As service was improper, respondent's motions for facially insufficiency are moot.

Dismissed.
