Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner, NYC Police Department did not appear; Respondent, appeared by authorized representative, Michael Nacmias, Esq.

The summons alleges a violation of NYC Administrative Code, section 19-190(B), failure to yield; right of way; physical injury.

Mr. Nacmias moved to dismiss the summons arguing that the affidavit of service is blank; that it was not filled out and cited Appeals # 2000420. Furthermore, a review of the original summons indicates that the supporting details of the charge do not set forth that the pedestrian had the right of way, which is an element of the cited offense, therefore, it fails to set forth a prima

facia case and must be dismissed,

I credit Mr. Nacmias's arguments and I grant his motion to dismiss the summons.

Accordingly, the summons is dismissed.
