Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted via telephone conference call on April 24, 2026.

Michael Nacmias, Esq. counsel for the Respondent, Gerald J. Joachim appeared at the hearing. No appearance on behalf of Petitioner, NYPD.

The summons charges AC 19-190 (b) Failure to Yield. Respondent made two motions. He argued that the case should be dismissed because the summons did not contain proof of service as the affidavit of service was blank, this defective and as such there is no jurisdiction. He also argued that the summons did not make out a prima facie case as it didn't link

Respondent to the activity, did not provide a description of the driver and did not meet the definition of physical injury.

Per 48 RCNY § 6-08(c)(1), the petitioner must file an original or copy of the summons, together with proof of service, with the Tribunal prior to the first scheduled hearing date.

I grant Respondent's motion and find there is lack of jurisdiction as the affidavit of service that accompanied the summons was blank.

I also find that that the details contained in the summons are conclusory and fail to allege material elements of the charge to support a prima facie case for the charge of AC 19-190 (b).
