Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent received an NYPD summons for a violation of Section 19-190(B) of the New York City Administrative Code. In the summons, the issuing officer (IO) stated that on February 27, 2026, pedestrian states while crossing s/b Marathon Pkwy over Northern Blvd in a marked crosswalk with cross signs was struck by front of 2018 Audi NY plate #MAA1121. Minor injury to leg.

In a phone in hearing, Mr. Michael Nacmias, attorney for Respondent, appeared. He made a motion to dismiss as the affidavit of service was blank. On the merits, he argued that the summons does not link the incident to the respondent. There is nothing that states that the respondent is driving. It does not state who has right of way. Additionally, the physical injury is

not sufficiently described.

Here, I grant Mr. Nacmias' motion to dismiss on defective service. The affidavit of service is blank. Therefore, I dismiss the violation.
