Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

A hearing was conducted by telephone on April 10, 2026. Michael Nacmias, Esq. appeared for the respondent. The petitioner did not appear. The summons alleged a violation of NYC Admin. Code sec. 19-190(b) in that the issuing officer was informed "by Juanita Young that motorist failed to yield to pedestrian." The respondent's attorney argued that the summons was defective on its face as it failed to allege that the respondent was the driver of a motor vehicle that caused any injury to a pedestrian. I agree with this argument as the summons does not allege that the respondent was the driver of a motor vehicle nor does it allege any injury to any pedestrian. As such, this summons is defective and is dismissed.
